

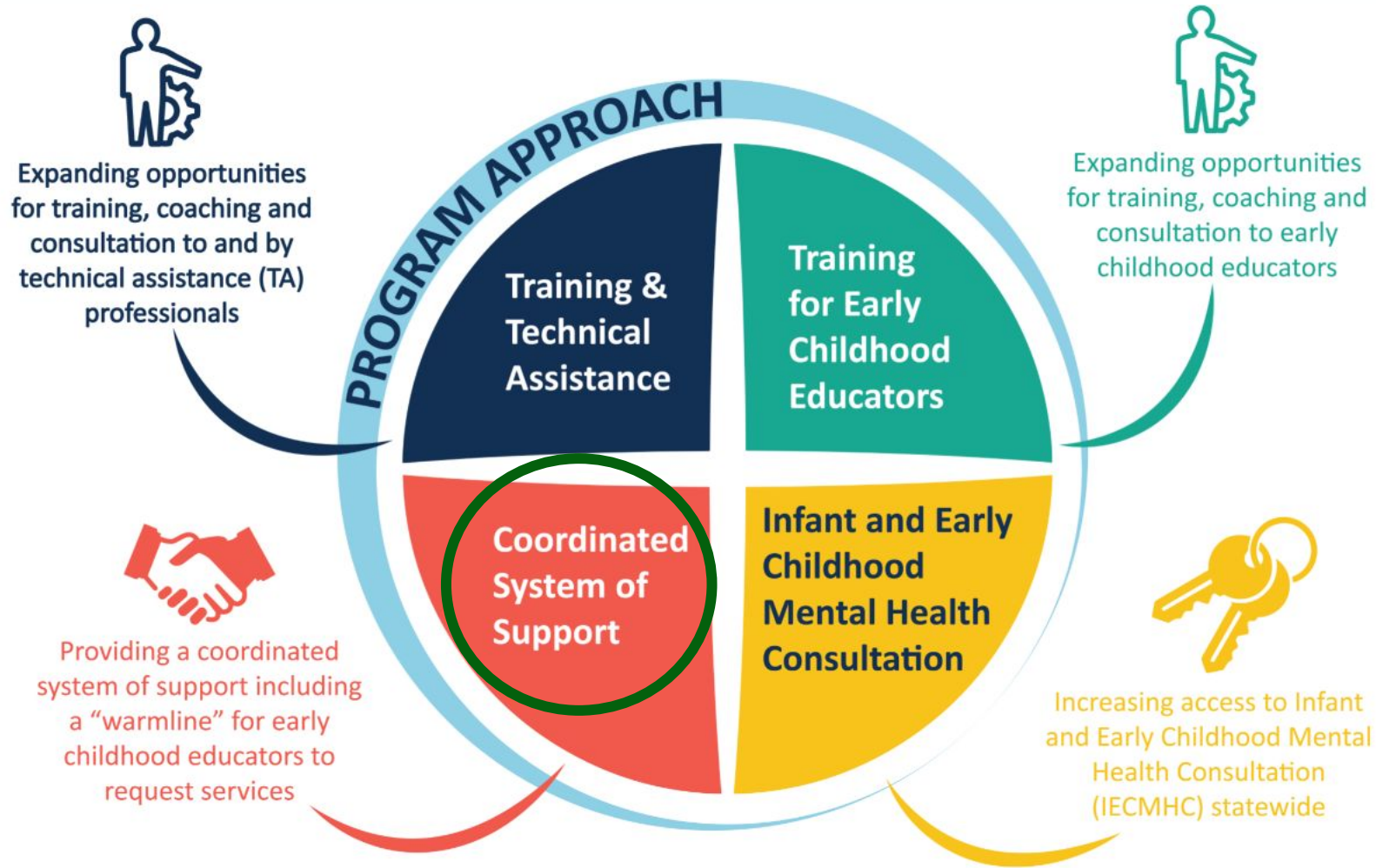

Scope of Work - ORIMHA





Project Objectives

1. Identify and define the output and outcome measures related to the creation and execution of a "warmline" /Regional Support Networks for early childhood educators to request services, and
2. Identify and define the output and outcome measures related to the implementation and impact of IECMHC.

Data Framework, Not Delivery Platform

- What is needed to evaluate impact of referral network and results connected to legislation
 - *Foundation for longitudinal evaluation*
 - *Data quality and privacy considerations*
- Data can be collected regardless of platform used (e.g. phone call, website form, mobile app, or other means)
 - *Network platform will need to link to other systems*
 - *Scalable and responsive*
 - *Access to data for site, regional, or other research TBD*

Phases of Referral Network Process

Intake

This is the area where the requestor first identifies a need and provides some basic information.

Based on the information captured, the conversation should lead to provide specific levels of support.

Referral

Recommended resources may be:

- 1) Technical assistance, training, or other self-service resources.
- 2) Referral to a mental health consultant.
- 3) Immediate intervention through other support and care coordinators.

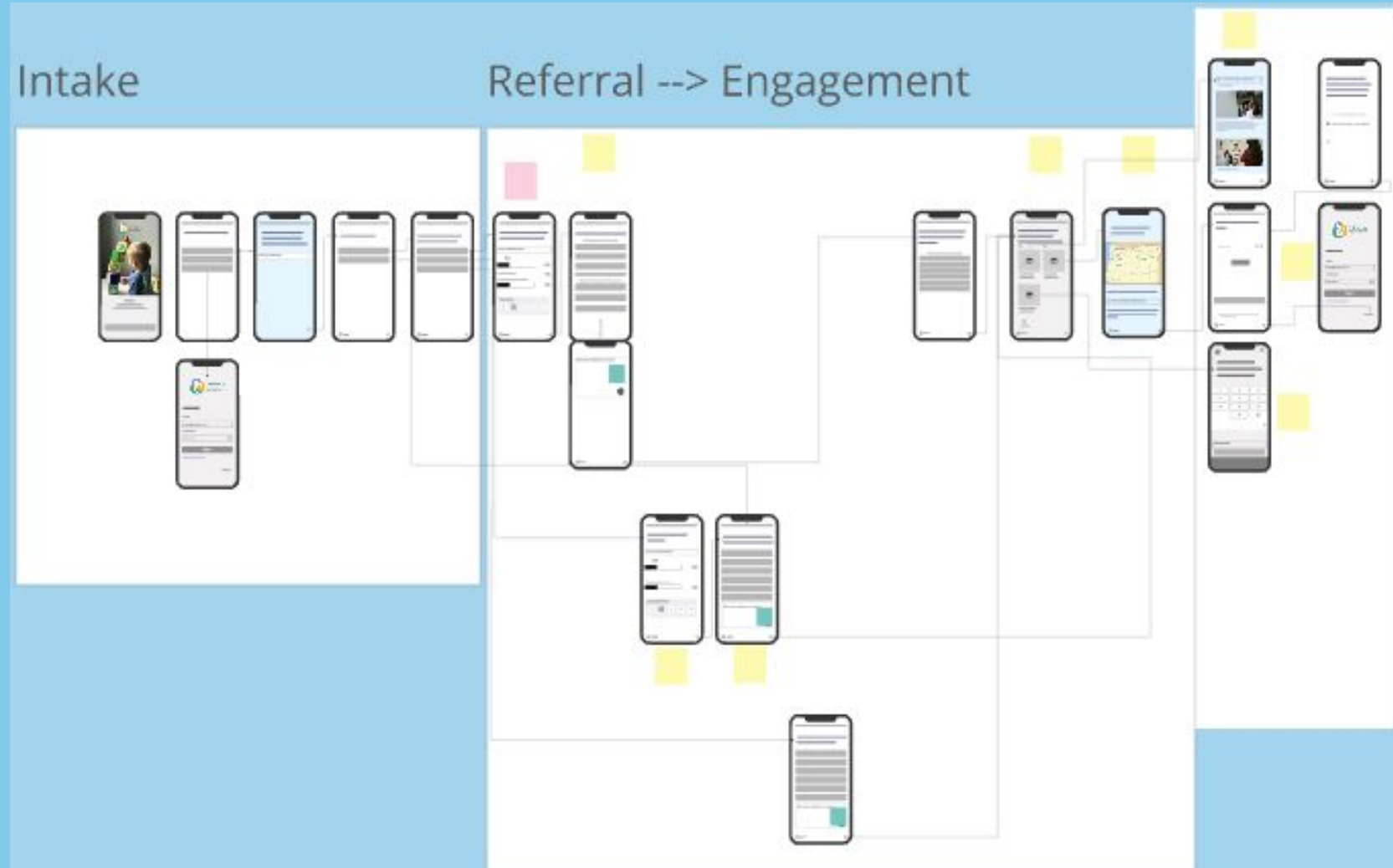
Engagement

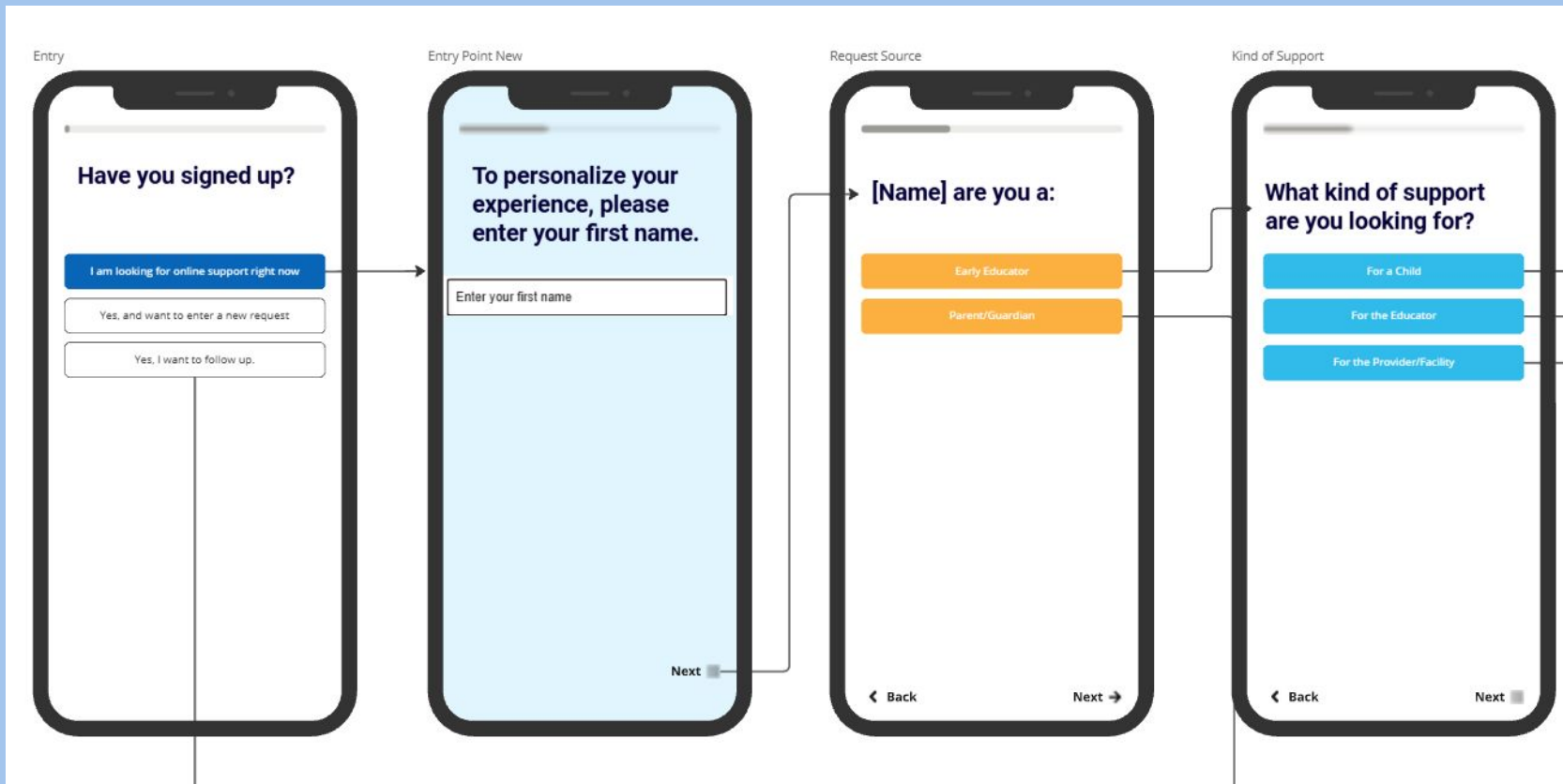
When a resource is used or assigned and engaged, this will trigger a new round of data collection regarding the services used, by whom, and for how long.

Evaluation

With sufficient data collected throughout the process, we can evaluate the effectiveness of resources based on needs and refine ongoing support.

ORIMHA Project: Bringing It All Together

Referral Network
The data needed to track the referral process from intake to engagement (February/March)



Mental Health Consultation

The data needed to document the components of MHC implementation (April/early May)

And other resource utilization and impact data as well!

Site Specific Information

Data elements that will inform impact of referral network and MHC (May/early June)
